The **Beak and Quill** welcomes letters to the Editor.

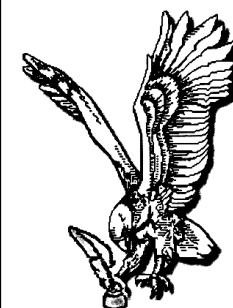

shown below.

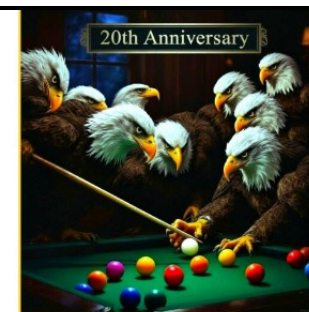

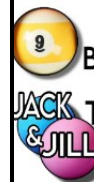
